### Local Non-Sanctioned Truck Pull

#### Rules and Regulations

**All drivers and vehicles must conform to rules as set out by the committee, or you will be immediately disqualified from the event.**

**A speed limit of 10km/hr is to be strictly observed on grounds at all times.**

**All decisions of track official will be final.**

**All classes must adhere to rules exceptions for each class with be list at the end of rules.**

1. Driver must be a minimum age of 16, with a valid driver's licence, and understand that they pull at own risk.
2. No Driver shall be under the influence of alcohol or illegal narcotics prior to pulling.
3. All trucks must be street legal, licensed and insured for the road. No dealer plates or trip permits are permitted. All vehicles must be burning ONLY stock fuel.
4. Pullers must be registered, with a number visible on vehicle left side dash and have signed the waiver prior to pulling. Cost to pull is \$20.00. Every registered puller is guaranteed one hook. Maximum pullers per class is 25. (Classes may allow for more than 25 pullers if other classes are not at maximum and under the discretion of the pulling committee).
5. All trucks must be registered prior to 12:30 p.m. start of event and pull in order of sign up/ registration.

6. All Drivers required a helmet, DOT approved helmet No bike helmets allowed.
7. NO passengers at any time during pulls and weigh in maximum weight 8400 lbs.
8. Trucks must be weighed and inspected prior to pulling. No added weights in the box allowed and boxes of pickups must be empty.
9. You will have 2 minutes to get to your position in line before your pull.
10. All vehicles must be in neutral or park while being hitched and unhitched.
11. Hitch point is to be the rearmost point of the truck with a maximum height of 22 inches. Reese style hitch only.
12. All pulls must start with a tight hitch. Contestants will be allowed two consecutive attempts at a 75 (seventy) feet to start sled.
13. All vehicles stop immediately upon judges signal. Any vehicles going out of bounds will be disqualified.
14. A pull of 300 feet is considered a full pull, finish will be determined on a floating finish thereafter.

### **Local 4 x 4 Diesel Class**

1. No Twin Turbos, trucks have Twin Turbos will be move to separate class.
2. 8400 lbs. is maximum weight

### **Open Class 8400 lbs.**

1. Drive shaft hoops at differential is minimum safety requirement
2. Hanging weight in front of bumper will be permitted
3. Truck does not need to be licensed.
4. This class is for any and all trucks with twin turbos.
